## **Executive Directive - 04/09**

Sub:- Internal Vigilance Cell for Kerala Police – instructions issued

To curb corrupt practices in Kerala Police it is decided to strengthen and activate the Internal Vigilance Mechanism in the Police Department. Officers specially selected by DGP will be authorized to conduct Surprise Checks on any ongoing Police activity taking place anywhere including those taking place in Police Stations, Circle Offices and Sub Division Offices or any Police Establishment under the DGP or any Police activity taking place in Public or in interaction with any member of the public. The Surprise Check Officer will check, for only acts of corruption.

If a known Officer of proven identity of and above the rank of DySP in Kerala Police discloses his identity as an Internal Vigilance Officer duly authorized by DGP, all Officers will be obliged to render necessary assistance to such officer in the carrying out the checking activity which he proposes to undertake. Such Internal Vigilance Officer shall always make a contemporaneous report of his activity / result of check and furnish a copy to the concerned Unit Head. The original and the Surprise Check report shall be sent to IGP, Administration or DGP in (N/c) by the Internal Vigilance Officer.

This should be brought to the notice of all the subordinate officers upto the rank of Police Constables.
